

The City of Burkburnett is always striving to find ways to improve our community. We actively compete with other communities for various monies offered through federal, state, and local grant programs. The City has been awarded the H.E.S. (hazard elimination program) grant through public works funding. The H.E.S. (hazard elimination program) grant project will begin in May of 2010. H.E.S program funds are eligible to cover 90 percent of project construction costs. The remaining 10 percent of project construction costs must be covered by state or local participation. The funds for this program are channeled through district TXDOT offices. With these funds, the City will be re-aligning the intersection at County, Kramer, and Ameron Rd. Ameron Rd. will be widened to align with County Rd. and an additional lane will be added as a turning lane onto Kramer Rd. Drainage improvements have also been added to this project to eliminate backup from storm drainage. Construction is scheduled to begin Tuesday June 1st and is expected to be completed prior to the beginning of the next school year.
